For the treatment of secondary bacterial infections that complicate primary respiratory infections in poultry, pigs and calves, caused by bacteria sensitive to oxytetracycline therapy.

For the treatment of gastro-enteritis in pigs and calves caused by bacteria sensitive to oxytetracycline therapy.

Contains: Oxytetracycline 200 g/kg

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Store in a cool dry place.

WARNINGS

- ALL FEED MEDICATED WITH OXYTET FG 200 MUST BE WITHDRAWN 7 DAYS BEFORE SLAUGHTER.
- Keep out of reach of uninformed persons, children and animals.
- Although this remedy has been extensively tested under a large variety of conditions, failure thereof may ensue as a result of a wide range of reasons. If this is suspected, seek veterinary advice and notify the registration holder.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: USE ONLY AS DIRECTED

The dosage rates given below are guidelines only – the inclusion rate should be determined by a veterinarian taking into account the incidence of disease and the severity of the challenge.

This supplement must be completely dispersed throughout the total feed available to the animal at the recommended rate. The required amount should first be mixed with ± 30 kg of feed, and the resultant be thoroughly blended with the balance of the batch.

Recommended at the following rates:

Poultry

- **Therapeutically –**
1 – 2 kg OXYTET FG 200 (i.e. 50 – 100 gram oxytetracycline activity) per 1 000 kg ration.
Therapy to be continued for 7 – 14 days.

Pigs

- **Therapeutically –**
1 – 4 kg OXYTET FG 200 (i.e. 50 – 200 gram oxytetracycline activity) per 1 000 kg ration.
Therapy to be continued for 7 – 14 days.

Cattle, calves and lambs

- **Therapeutically –**
0,5 – 3 kg OXYTET FG 200 (i.e. 25 – 150 gram oxytetracycline activity) per 1 000 kg ration.
Therapy to be continued for 7 – 14 days.
